Bath Parks and Recreation Programs Behavior Policy

Please read the "examples of unacceptable behavior" with your athlete before the start of any of our programs.

We ask that all participants look out for and respect one another. Participants should talk to a coach or facilitator if they are uncomfortable with any experience during programming. We want your child to have FUN and be safe!!!

Examples of Unacceptable Behavior:

- Refusing to follow behavior guidelines or general rules.
- Using profanity, vulgarity, or obscenity
- Stealing or damaging property (personal or others property)
- Refusal to participate in activities or cooperate with coaches.
- Disrupting an activity
- Endangering the health and safety of children and/or staff
- Use of illicit drugs, alcohol or tobacco or sexual conduct of any kind
- · Teasing, making fun or bullying of other participants or staff
- Fighting of any kind

Program fees are *non-refundable* if a participant is asked to stop attending due to disciplinary reasons. Physical violence or bullying toward another participant or coach will result in immediate dismissal from the program.

Bullying is inexcusable and unacceptable. Each participant is expected to treat all other participants with respect and to help each other achieve the best possible experience. If a participant has difficulty meeting this expectation, parents will be called upon to assist and resolve. We work together to ensure that all participants gain self-confidence, make new friends, and go home with a happy, positive experience.
